Blake Anderson, who created Stage Rags (changed to All Dressed Up in 1990) passed away on July 2nd, at the age of 61 of complications from alcoholism.

Blake was born December 15, 1946 in Aurora and grew up in Batavia and Elburn. He spent his entire life in the performing arts.....notably performing with Guy Little at the "Little Theatre on the Square" in Sullivan, Illinois before heading to Broadway where he performed in productions of "Hair" and "Jesus Christ Superstar." He was called to Australia to join the cast of "Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band," where he met John Lennon who conceived this Beatle's production.

He returned home to create his own costume company, and spent the rest of his live creating professional quality costumes for theatre companies throughout the area.
